Our **Building and Refurbishing Computers Program** offers a structured but flexible pathway for participants to learn how to build, understand and gain confidence with computers. We recognise that every individual has different skills and capabilities – but we also set clear goals with a view to develop and empower everyone who joins the Flash Drive community.

Participants advance through three levels at their own pace – with clear instructions and support.

LEVEL 1

Distinguishing different components in the computer and what their name and function is.

LEVEL 2

Plugging in a computer and seeing if it works then disassemble that computer taking note of where everything goes and then reassembling the computer and seeing if it still works.

LEVEL 3

Installing an operating system (windows), installing software and diagnosing different problems that may arise.

During the program, we encourage participants to work towards taking home a PC that they have built.
