Our **Recycling eWaste Program** offers a structured but flexible pathway for participants to learn, understand and gain confidence with computers and eWaste. We recognise that every individual has different skills and capabilities – but we also set clear goals with a view to develop and empower everyone who joins the Flash Drive community.

Participants advance through three levels at their own pace – with clear instructions and support.

LEVEL 1

Removing and cutting plastic from the cables and sorting them into different grades of copper.

LEVEL 2

Dismantling hard drives, DVD drives, floppy drives and printers and sorting them into different areas of recycling

LEVEL 3

Dismantling computers and sorting components into what can be repurposed (ram, video cards etc.) and what we recycle (cases steel, parts off the motherboard stainless steel)

Our team has a proven track-record of working successfully in community development, training, and working with our participants to realise their true potential. We do this by mentoring to build self-esteem and confidence, and improving social capacity – while learning practical, hands-on skills.
